The Community Action Partnership of Natrona County (CAPNC) will hold a public hearing for the purpose of obtaining input on the use of Community Services Block Grant (CSBG) funds in Natrona County for its FFY 2024 Community Action Plan beginning October 1, 2023. A presentation in compliance with the CSBG requirements will be held on May 24th, 2023 at 12:00 noon in the Community Action Partnership Conference Room, 606 S David Street, Casper, Wyoming.

Established in 1984 as the Human Services Commission, and changed to designated name by Natrona County Board of County Commissioners in 2003 to Community Action Partnership of Natrona County. CAPNC has a 9 member established tripartite Board of Directors and serves as the designated CSBG entity for Natrona County. CAPNC focuses on removing barriers for those experiencing the impacts of poverty, seeks to foster community partnerships that extend resources and create conditions where individuals/families have opportunities to increase their social and economic mobility.
